- To lead in the assessment, treatment and rehabilitation of all first team players
- Coordinate external diagnostic and/or specialist consultations based on clinical need
- Create and deliver advanced rehabilitation programmes centred on player specific performance demands
- Create and deliver robust fitness testing, injury reduction and injury prevention programmes centred on player specific performance demands
- Oversee and assist the other Therapists to ensure a consistent provision of medical care across the first team and academy
- Update training and matchday emergency action plans annually
- Maintain/manage all medical department equipment and consumables
- Oversee matchday emergency aid cover for all venue
- Perform pre-contractual medical assessment of prospective first team players
- Produce pre-contractual risk report of prospective first team players
- Provide continuous communication of squad availability to the First Team Manager
- Provide weekly squad availability updates to the Chairman and Sporting Director
- Maintain accurate and professional documentation in line with industry standards
- Other tasks as required
