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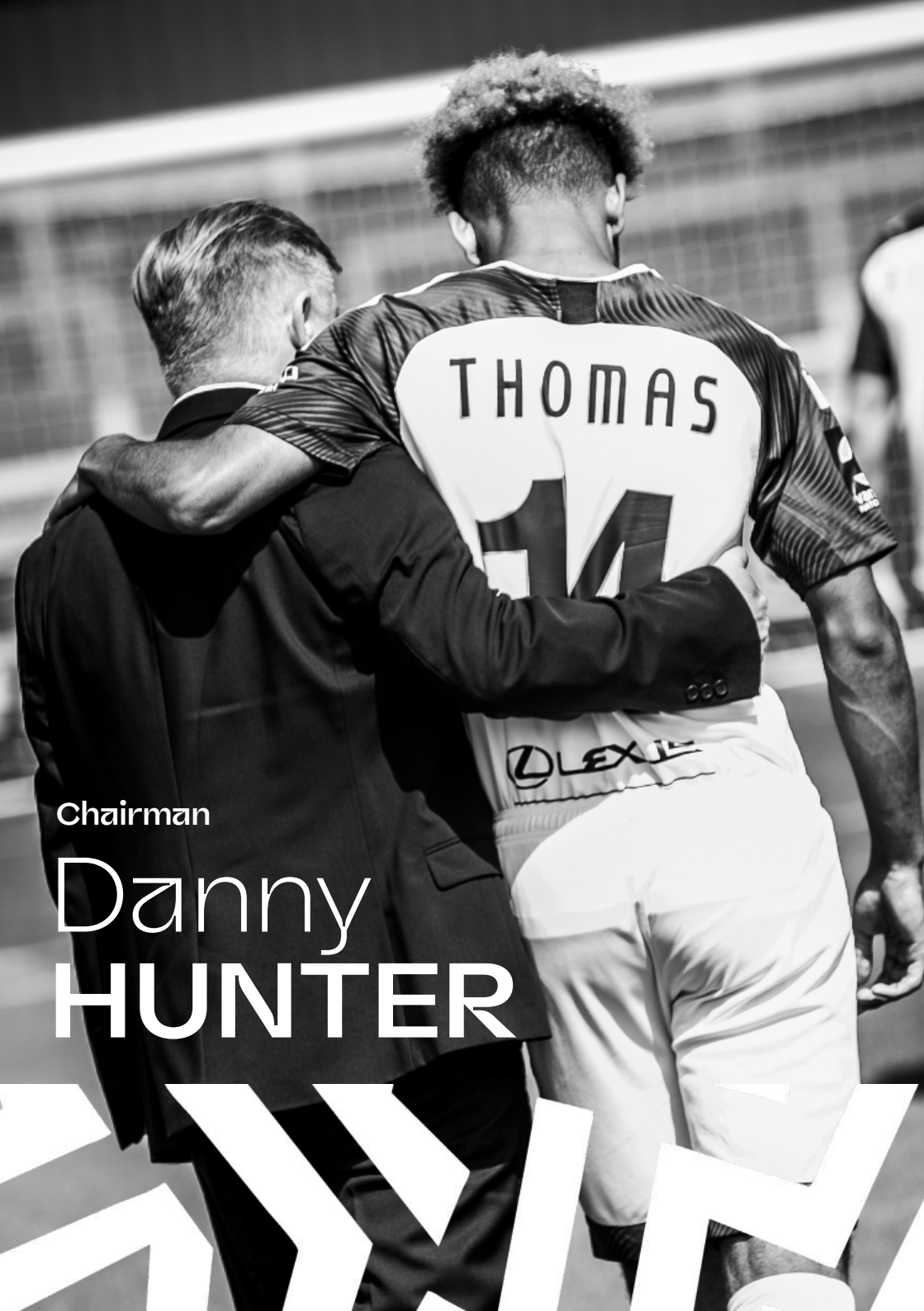

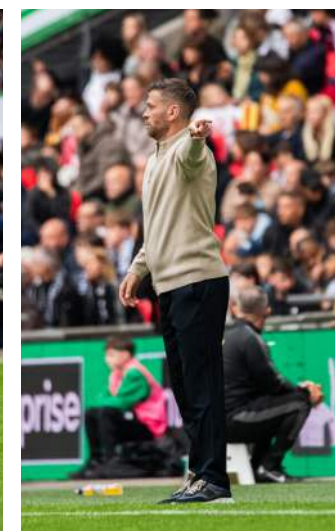
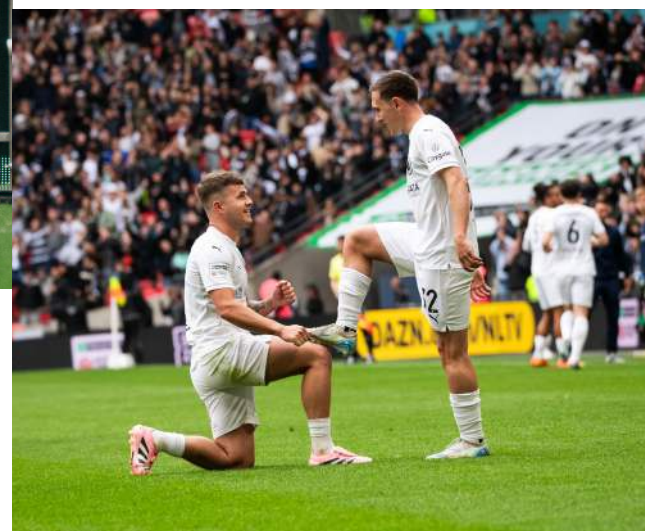

The highly regarded UEFA Pro Licence coach arrived with extensive experience across academy and senior football, having held coaching roles at Southampton, Watford, Bristol City and Manchester United, while also managing Forest Green Rovers and serving as caretaker head coach at Bristol Rovers.

Known for his player-centred coaching philosophy and commitment to youth development, Horseman brings a wealth of experience to one of English football's most productive academies. His background across both elite academies and the senior game provides valuable insight as Arsenal continue to develop the club's brightest young prospects. The Gunners will hope his expertise can help prepare more academy players for the demands of first-team football in the years ahead.

Andre Harriman-Annous is one of Arsenal's brightest attacking prospects, having progressed through the Hale End academy after joining from Tottenham in 2016. A versatile forward capable of playing centrally or out wide, the England youth international has impressed with his pace, technical ability and intelligent movement.

Known for his direct running and eye for goal, Harriman-Annous has continued to develop at Under-21 level while gaining valuable experience around the first-team environment. Arsenal will hope the talented forward can maintain his progress as he pushes closer to senior football.

Brayden CLARKE



Clarke joined Arsenal from Wolves in 2024 and is regarded as one of the club's most promising young defenders. The Wales youth international is comfortable at centre-back or right-back, with his composure in possession and defensive maturity standing out since arriving at Hale End.

Known for his calmness on the ball and strong defensive instincts, Clarke has continued to make encouraging progress through the academy.

Ceadach O'NEILL



Ceadach O'Neill joined Arsenal from Linfield in 2024 and is regarded as one of the club's brightest young midfielders. The Northern Ireland international earned his senior debut during the 2025/26 season, highlighting his continued progress alongside his development at Hale End.

Known for his composure, vision and passing range, O'Neill has continued to impress at Under-21 level. Arsenal will hope he can build on his international breakthrough and continue pushing towards senior football.

Arsenal FC

Football historian **Leigh Edwards** profiles ten leading Arsenal FC Managers

Herbert CHAPMAN

Legendary manager Herbert Chapman made Arsenal the power in the land. A former inside-forward, he appeared for several clubs including Spurs before rejoining Northampton as player-boss in April 1907. He guided them to the Southern League title in 1908/09, then managed Leeds City and guided Huddersfield to FA Cup and League Championship glory. Appointed Arsenal's manager in June 1925, he took the Gunners to three FA Cup finals including their 1930 Wembley success and the League Championship in 1930/31. He died in January 1934 but as at Huddersfield his side went on to win the title in three successive seasons.

George ALLISON

George Allison managed Arsenal either side of the Second World War. A broadcaster and journalist, he was Arsenal's programme editor before joining the board of directors. He became secretary-manager in June 1934, guiding Arsenal to the League Championship in 1934/35 and 1937/38. Also plotting success in the 1936 FA Cup final and 1943 League South Cup, his brainchild was Highbury's East Stand, built in 1936. Remaining in charge until retiring in May 1947, he maintained his links with the media, being London correspondent of the 'New York Herald' for 35 years. He died in Golders Green in March 1957.

Tom WHITTAKER

Tom Whittaker managed Arsenal to the League Championship in 1947/48 and 1952/53. Following wartime service in the Army and Navy, he joined Arsenal in November 1919, making 64 First Division appearances at left-back and left-half until his playing career was ended

by a knee injury. He assisted George Hardy before succeeding him as trainer in February 1927 and contributed to Arsenal's successes under Herbert Chapman, then George Allison. Appointed secretary-manager in June 1947, he also guided the Gunners to FA Cup final glory in 1950, then the FA Cup final again in 1952. He died in London in October 1956.

Jack CRAYSTON

England international right-half Jack Crayston was both a player and manager at Arsenal. Initially with Ulverston, he joined Barrow in August 1928 and moved via Bradford PA to Highbury for £5,250 in May 1934. He helped Arsenal twice win the League Championship and the FA Cup in 1936, netting 16 goals in 168 First Division games until injury ended his career in December 1943. Joining Arsenal's coaching staff, he assisted Tom Whittaker before succeeding him as manager between November 1956 and May 1958. He later managed Doncaster Rovers, then was a newsagent near Birmingham and died on Boxing Day 1992.

George SWINDIN

Long-serving goalkeeper George Swindin was both a player and manager at Arsenal. A former Rotherham United amateur, he joined Bradford City in February 1933 and moved to Highbury for £4,000 in April 1936. He helped Arsenal win the League Championship in 1937/38, 1947/48 and 1952/53, also starring in the Gunners' 1950 FA Cup final success. Making 271 First Division appearances, he became Peterborough United's player-boss in February 1954, then rejoined Arsenal as manager between July 1958 and April 1962. He managed Norwich City and Cardiff City, then ran a garage and died in Kettering in October 2005.

Bertie MEE

Bertie Mee managed Arsenal to the League Championship and FA Cup 'double' in 1970/71. A Derby County reserve winger shortly before the Second World War, he qualified as a physiotherapist in the RAMC and spent 12 years as a rehabilitation officer for disabled servicemen. He became Arsenal's trainer and physiotherapist in August 1960, then manager in June 1966. Also guiding the Gunners to two consecutive League Cup finals, Fairs Cup final success in 1970 and the 1972 FA Cup final, he remained in charge until July 1976. He was later Watford's general manager, then a director and died in October 2001.

Terry NEILL

Former Northern Ireland international centre-half Terry Neill managed Arsenal to three successive FA Cup finals, including their 1979 triumph. Initially with Bangor, he moved to Arsenal in December 1959 and became captain of club and country. He was also chairman of the PFA and played for the Gunners in the 1968 League Cup final, scoring eight times in 241 League games prior to joining Hull City as player-boss in June 1970. Also managing Northern Ireland, then Tottenham Hotspur, he returned to Arsenal as manager between July 1976 and December 1983. He later ran a sports bar in central London and died in July 2022.

Don HOWE

Ex-England international right-back Don Howe gave Arsenal marvellous service in various capacities. He turned professional with West Brom in November 1952 and moved to Arsenal for £42,000 in April 1964. Scoring once in 70 League games, he became the Gunners' first-team coach in October 1967 and helped to plot the 1970/71 'double' triumph. He rejoined West Brom as manager in July 1971 but returned to Arsenal as coach, then manager from December 1983 until March 1986. After various coaching and management posts, he rejoined Arsenal for a third spell as

head youth coach for six years and died in December 2015.

George GRAHAM

Former Scotland international George Graham managed Arsenal to all three major domestic honours and the ECWC in 1994. He played for Aston Villa and Chelsea prior to joining Arsenal in exchange for Tommy Baldwin in September 1966. Starring as the Gunners won the Fairs Cup in 1970 and 'double' in 1970/71, he netted 59 goals in 227 League games before moving to Manchester United for £120,000 in December 1972. He played for Portsmouth and Crystal Palace, then managed Millwall prior to rejoining Arsenal as manager between May 1986 and February 1995. Later in charge of Leeds United and Spurs, he worked in the media.



Arsene WENGER

French manager Arsene Wenger guided Arsenal to the Premier League and FA Cup 'double' in 1997/98 and 2001/02. A former defender with Strasbourg, he spent three years in charge of Nancy, becoming Monaco's manager in July 1987. He steered them to the French League title in 1988 and French Cup success in 1991, then had a spell in charge of Japanese side Grampus Eight. Appointed Arsenal's boss in September 1996, he plotted their record-breaking 2003/04 Premier League title triumph and led them to the 2006 Champions League final as well as further FA Cup glory in 2003, 2005, 2014, 2015 and 2017. He left in May 2018.

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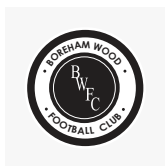
