Since our promotion to the National League in 2015, we have steadily become an established National League club, year-on-year competing for play-offs at Non-League's top table. During the 2021/22 season, the Club were thrust into the national spotlight, reaching the Emirates FA Cup 5th Round and taking on Everton at Goodison Park, becoming just the tenth Non-League side in FA Cup history to reach the last 16 of the prestigious competition. Last season, became just the 3rd Non-League side ever to reach the FA Cup 3rd Round in three consecutive seasons, as well as reaching the play-off semi-finals too, losing to eventual play-off winners Notts County after extra-time.

An exciting opportunity has become available within our medical department at Boreham Wood FC to work as the Consultant Physiotherapist.
