OVERVIEW

Boreham Wood FC are a professional, family-run, community-focused football club, who following relegation will compete in the Vanarama National League South for the 2024-25 season. The Club is actively looking for a managerial replacement for our long-serving Manager Luke Garrard.

As mentioned, the club is family-run and holds the values of community, relationships, and togetherness at the heart of the organisation. The club is extremely stable both on and off the pitch, employing just two Managers since 2008, whilst the club's diverse business model will allow for a very competitive budget for the National League South heading into the 2024-25 campaign.

After relegation disappointment, the club's ambitions are to bounce back to the Vanarama National League at the first attempt, with the playing squad well positioned and a number of talented players contracted for next season and beyond. That said, the club's next managerial appointment is a crucial piece in the jigsaw to achieve on-field success, and the club totally understands that we require good leadership in the dressing room and good recruitment to complement the existing squad.

The club believes this is a great opportunity for a hardworking, focused and ambitious Manager/Head Coach to take both themselves and the club forward. The club's business model and structures mean that the club carries no historical debt, it is stable with an established top-end non-league academy and has a loyal staff structure that will offer a new manager an environment to thrive within.

At this time, we ask that only candidates with a proven track record at our level or above, who live within a one-hour commute from the club's stadium apply for the position.

- Work in conjunction with the Club's Sporting Director to develop, implement and deliver a recruitment policy, including talent identification and networking with key stakeholders
- To report to and liaise with the Chairman, Sporting Director and Finance Director on budget management and oversight
- To liaise with senior management, whether that be commercial, academy, administration, community trust etc., to be the conduit between football and non-football functions at BWFC
- To work with the Club's media department and senior management to promote the Club and its initiatives, whether First Team or otherwise, in a positive light
- When necessary, to represent the Club when asked on all footballing matters such as League meetings etc. in conjunction with the Club Secretary
- In direct liaison with the Club Secretary, to ensure the Club adheres to the FA and National League regulations and competition rules
- To attend Club events and initiatives where required including commercial, academy and community trust
- To ensure Club procedures, policies and standards are upheld at all times by themself, as well as First Team players and staff.
