

Senior Therapist

OVERVIEW

An exciting opportunity has become available within the medical department at Boreham Wood FC to work as the club's Senior Therapist, leading the medical provision with the club's first team squad for the 2024/25 season. We are looking to recruit a physiotherapist or sports therapist to lead the diagnosis, treatment and injury prevention of the first team playing squad here at Meadow Park.

The role will be based at the club's stadium, as such it is advantageous that applicants live within convenient travelling distance of our Stadium, preferably under a one-hour commute. This is an excellent opportunity to work at a vibrant, ambitious and continuously growing Football Club in the National League South.

ROLES/RESPONSIBILITIES

- Oversee training and matches including but not limited to pre- and post-session/match treatment, prehab programmes, assessment/diagnosis of injuries and rehab programmes
- Design specific rehabilitation and treatment plans outside of the normal training sessions and matches for injured players until return to play and full fitness is achieved
- Implement fitness testing, injury reduction/prevention strategies and programmes
- Work closely with the First Team Manager, especially on injury diagnosis, reporting processes and expected return to play
- Work closely with the sports science department, especially regarding player loading through the club's GPS tracking system, as well as the player's strength and conditioning programmes
- Oversee the timetabling and management of the medical department's interns and placement students, alongside the club's Lead Academy Therapist, including the management relationships with placement providers and other medical partnerships
- Upkeep cleanliness of all medical areas and gym equipment, as well as ensuring that all medical and gym equipment is fully operational
- Maintain all medical admin, including ensuring all medical notes are kept up to date
- Other tasks as required...
