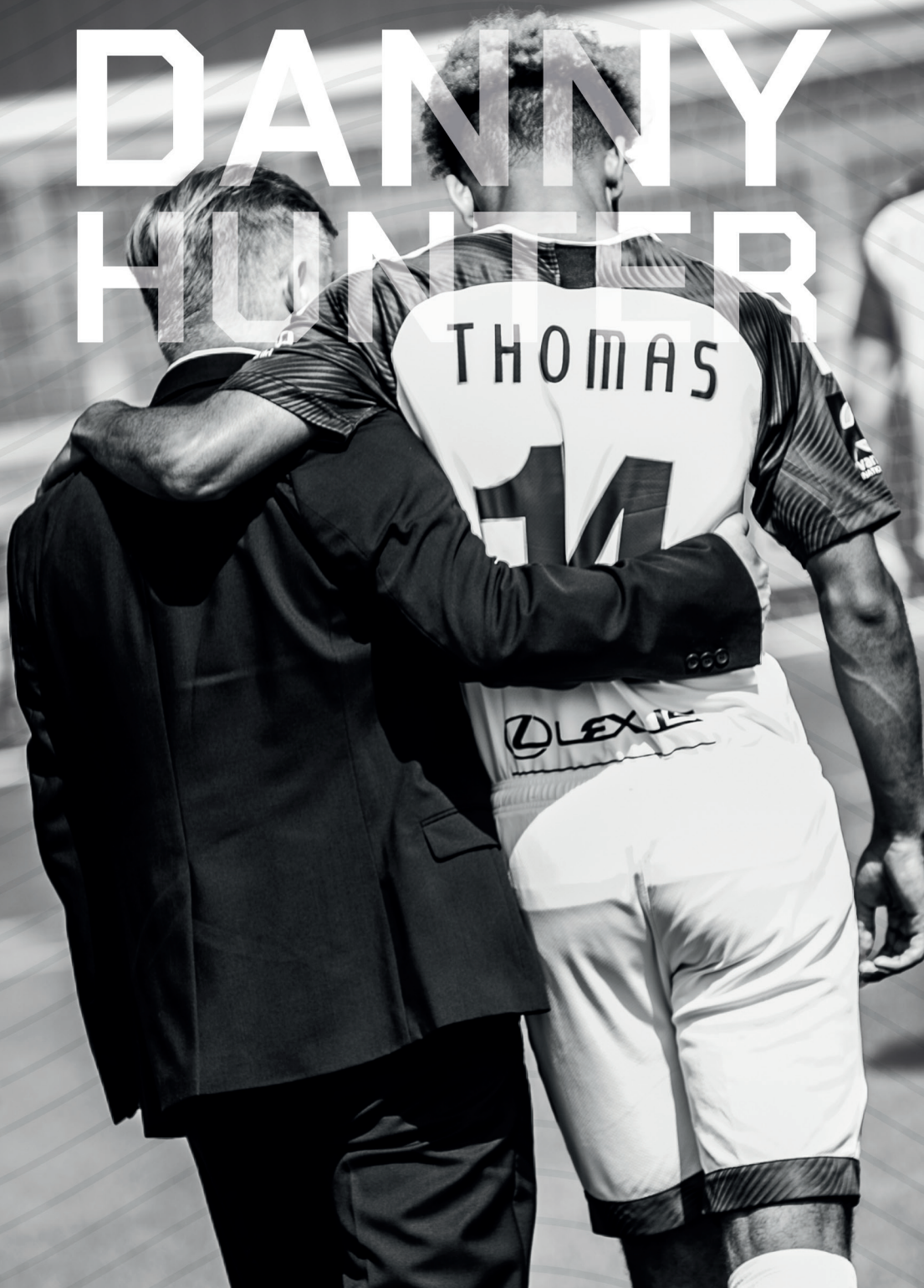

# DANNY HUNTER





***Today we welcome Torquay United to the Mangata Pay UK stadium.  
May I wish their Directors, Manager, players and supporters an  
enjoyable time with us and a safe journey home later.***

Well, it's been a win-one, lose-one, win-one run in our last three league games and there, perhaps, lies our early season problem in a nutshell and it's a problem we are determined to solve.

Since Luke Garrard returned to the club, we have beaten 3rd place Eastbourne United 1-0 at their place, knocking them out of the FA Cup. We have drawn 0-0 away at current leaders Weston Super Mare, after dominating large parts of the game. We then beat Farnborough here 3-1 who at present sit 5th, whilst also beating Truro 1-0 here, who currently sit 2nd.

Amongst that lot, we inexplicably go and lose 1-0 to bottom of the table Aveley and any momentum built was lost and in truth we're left scratching our heads. From there we went and knocked out Felixstowe and Walton United very comfortably last Saturday in the FA Trophy, haha - in all seriousness we were pretty poor once again - though if you take the emotion out of it, we still deservedly levelled late on to take it to penalties - once again our goalkeeper Nathan Ashmore stepped forward and came to our rescue, so again take a bow Mr Ashmore.

My belief as we complete the first third of the season quite simply is.... if we can all look at ourselves with a bit more honesty, we can quietly re-set, re-focus and start to impose ourselves on this division and if we can use this pre Christmas window to

improve ourselves by small margins, then collectively our season can get back on track and optimism can slowly return.

This afternoon we welcome our old adversaries and very good friends from Devon, Torquay United, and as always, whenever we play them we know we're in for a very tough game. I'm sure today will be no different and so I expect another tight and cagey affair.

In my recent notes, I've touched on the need for our club and dressing room to show togetherness, character, attitude, discipline and desire. As such, after some very constructive discussions with our Gaffer Luke Garrard and Sporting Director Charlie Hunter, we feel a slight re-boot and mini squad rebuild is needed - but to be very clear, it is a mini squad rebuild, built on evolution rather than revolution.

That said, a positive result today against an ex-football league club, who I consider to be the biggest in our division, can re-set the dressing room bar and re-set the tone for the rest of our season. A positive mindset, positive performance and a positive result today will bring renewed confidence to us in our run-up to Christmas and hopefully set us up for an improved second half of the season.

Off the park, John Goddard has been allowed to depart for pastures new



and we genuinely wish John well, Cameron Coxe has been allowed to go out on loan to Salisbury City for three months to get more game time. However, our squad is still slightly oversized as we begin our mini-rebuild in earnest.

As such, you can expect one or two others to be allowed to leave or go out on loan, especially if their game time decreases substantially or dries up. Any departures though will not be knee-jerk reactions - but necessary after the Aveley defeat, after the FA Trophy game and if we don't want to continue to sit on the fringes of the play-offs.

Our search for the right players, characters and winning formula, has already brought us Jayden Richardson and Jon Benton to assist in the rebuild process and we hope that strengthening our ranks, even by small margins, will improve our quality and options in key areas and those small margins are sometimes all it takes.

We know our season has yet to hit the highs, we know our player search is still not finished and our player recruitment and character checks are still ongoing - but recent performances and results still show us that we do need to bring in one or two more quality players into the club should the chance present itself.

That said they will have to be the right type of player, one who shows they have the ability, attitude, discipline, desire, work rate, leadership and character to improve what is already a very good squad. My job here for more than 25 years has been to care for, invest in, plan, scheme, build and

improve our football club from top to bottom and bottom to top.

I'm still doing that no matter how small the margins may seem, yes the lines at times do get blurred - but I must continue to lead, continue to invest, build and continue to trust in the process - nothing's over until it's over and small margins do matter.

Anyway back to today, let's hope for an open, attacking game and may the best team win.

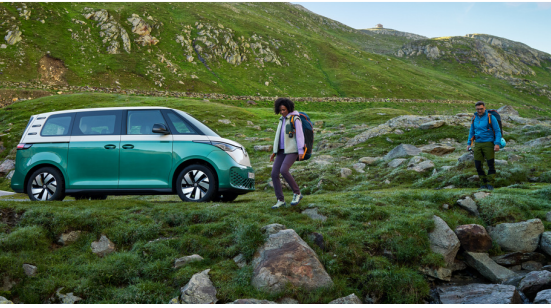

## Manager: Paul WOTTON

Wotton began his coaching career at Plymouth Argyle, serving as first-team coach and later assistant manager under Derek Adams. After leaving Argyle in 2019, he became manager of Truro City, leading them to National League South promotion in 2022/23. Finally, in May of this year, Wotton was appointed manager of the Gulls on a three-year contract following the club's takeover by the Bryn Consortium, marking the next chapter in management.

# ONES TO WATCH



## James HAMON

**Born:** Guernsey - 1 July 1995

**Position:** Goalkeeper

Guernsey-born goalkeeper, James Hamon began his career with Exeter City in 2013, making 37 first-team appearances and gaining National League South experience on loan at Hayes & Yeading and Gloucester City. He joined Truro City in 2019, becoming their first-choice goalkeeper under Paul Wotton. Hamon played a key role in Truro's promotion to National League South in 2022/23 after a brief loan stint with Torquay United during the 2021 season.



## Cody COOKE

**Born:** Truro - 2 March 1993

**Position:** Striker

31-year-old, Cody Cooke joined Torquay United after scoring 55 goals in 130 appearances over three successful seasons with Bath City. Starting his career at Penryn Athletic, Cooke's standout form for Truro City earned him a move to Scottish Premier League side St Mirren, where he memorably netted a hat-trick against Dundee. The forward joined the Gulls in the summer and is Paul Wotton's side's leading goal scorer at this stage in the campaign.



## Jordan DYER

**Born:** Exeter - 29 May 2000

**Position:** Defender

Jordan began his career at Exeter City, where he made 10 first-team appearances for his hometown club. After gaining significant experience within the non-League circuit during loan spells with Bideford, Tiverton, Chippenham and Yeovil, it was at Bath that Dyer's career hit new heights, with two successful loan spells prompting a permanent move to the Romans in 2022, the defender enjoyed two successful seasons at Twerton Park until joining the Gulls in the summer.

## CLASSIC CAMPAIGNS

# TORQUAY UNITED

Football historian **LEIGH EDWARDS** selects ten post-war Torquay United 'Classic Campaigns'

### 1954/55

Player-manager Eric Webber guided Torquay United to the FA Cup fourth round in 1954/55. New signings included Alf Jefferies from Brentford, Jack Smith from Liverpool and John Smith from Plymouth. They beat Cambridge United 4-0 and Blyth Spartans 3-1, then gained a 2-2 FA Cup third round draw at Leeds United before winning 4-0 in the replay at Plainmoor: Alf Jefferies, John Smith, Harry Smith, Dennis Lewis, Eric Webber, Griff Norman, Ron Shaw, Sammy Collins, Harold Dobbie, Don Mills, Jack Smith. Torquay lost 1-0 to Huddersfield in the fourth round watched by a record 21,908 crowd at Plainmoor.

### 1956/57

Torquay United narrowly failed to win promotion to the Second Division in 1956/57. Eric Webber's side began with a 4-1 victory at home to Ipswich Town and lost just one of their first eight games to go top of the table. Torquay remained unbeaten at Plainmoor and slammed seven goals past Millwall, Swindon Town and Norwich City, but a poor away record and an injury to Ron Shaw hit their hopes. Torquay needed to win their last match at Crystal Palace to clinch promotion but a 1-1 draw enabled Ipswich Town to pip them to the Third Division (South) title on goal average. Sammy Collins was top scorer with 30 goals.

### 1959/60

Torquay United won promotion for the first time in their history in 1959/60. Newcomers included Eddie Marsh from Luton Town, Dennis Penford from Reading and Colin Rawson from Millwall. Eric Webber's side began with a 2-1 victory at home to Doncaster and

went top of the table in early October after five consecutive away wins. They trounced Northampton 7-1 in the FA Cup first round and maintained their promotion challenge in the New Year, with Dave Hancock returning to midfield. Promotion was assured with a 2-0 win at home to Gillingham. Graham Bond was top scorer, while Colin Bettany was ever-present.

### 1965/66

New manager Frank O'Farrell guided Torquay United back to the Third Division in 1965/66. Tommy Spratt followed him from Weymouth and other newcomers included Doug Clarke from Hull City and Alan Kirkman from Scunthorpe. The Gulls were early pace-setters after four successive wins and centre-half Reg Wyatt starred as they gained 21 points out of a possible 26. Two mid-season arrivals were John Bond from West Ham and Ronnie Barnes from Peterborough as Torquay finished with a six match unbeaten run and sealed promotion with a 0-0 draw at Darlington. Tommy Spratt and Robin Stubbs scored 35 goals overall.

### 1967/68

Torquay United went close to winning promotion to the Second Division in 1967/68. Summer signings included Bobby Baxter, Jimmy Dunne and former England international Ken Brown, while Tony Scott, Alan Welsh and Bill Kitchener arrived during the season. Torquay were unbeaten in their first 10 League games and led the table in early October. Andy Donnelly replaced John Dunn in goal and Torquay went clear at the top after beating rivals Bury 3-0 at Plainmoor in mid-March. The Gulls were proclaimed

promotion certainties but they won just two of their last 10 games and finished fourth in the Third Division.

### 1970/71

Allan Brown guided Torquay United to the FA Cup fourth round for only the third time in 1970/71. New signings were Dick Edwards from Aston Villa, Cliff Jackson from Crystal Palace and Mike Mahoney from Bristol City. The Gulls started well in the Third Division and defeated fellow high-fliers Preston 3-1, Fulham 3-1 and Aston Villa 1-0 before Christmas, also beating Villa 3-1 in the FA Cup first round. They then defeated Chelmsford 1-0 and Lincoln 4-3 prior to losing 3-0 at Leicester City in the fourth round. Torquay completed the double over Plymouth but finished 10th after a run of 11 games without a win.

### 1988/89

Torquay United became the first Devon club to reach a Wembley final in 1988/89. Cyril Knowles had managed the Gulls to the Fourth Division play-off final the previous season and starlet Lee Sharpe was sold to Manchester United. Torquay beat Cardiff 3-1, Gillingham 3-0, Bristol Rovers 1-0, Brentford 1-0 and holders Wolves 3-2 to reach the Sherpa Van Trophy final. Dean Edwards gave Torquay the lead but Bolton Wanderers won 4-1 at Wembley: Kenny Allen, Daral Pugh, Tom Kelly, Jim McNichol, Matt Elliott, Mark Loram, Carl Airey (Jimmy Smith), Phil Lloyd, Dean Edwards, Ian Weston (Sean Joyce), John Morrison.

### 1990/91

Torquay United won the Fourth Division play-off final in 1990/91. New signings Gareth Howells, Wes Saunders, Tommy Tynan and Peter Whiston made their debuts as the Gulls began with a 2-2 draw at Walsall, racing to the top of the table as they remained unbeaten in their first 14 League games. Dave Smith resigned at the start of April after a slump in results but Torquay qualified for the play-offs following a seven-match unbeaten run under his successor John Impey. They beat Burnley 2-1 to reach Wembley for the second

time in three seasons, defeating Blackpool on penalties after a 2-2 draw to clinch promotion.

### 2003/04

David Graham scored 22 goals as Torquay United won promotion in 2003/04. Craig Taylor was appointed captain after moving from Plymouth and formed a fine central defensive partnership with Steve Woods. Torquay lost just two of their first ten games, also signing left-back Brian McGlinchey from Plymouth in September. Leroy Rosenior's side overcame a lean spell with eight wins in nine matches and climbed into the promotion frame after beating Cambridge United 3-0 in March. Liam Rosenior arrived on loan from Fulham, helping to clinch third position on goal difference with a 2-1 win at Southend in their final game.



### 2008/09

Torquay United regained Football League status in 2008/09. Paul Buckle's side won just one of their opening seven games but soared into the Conference National title race with a thrilling 14 match unbeaten run. They also beat Championship side Blackpool en route to the FA Cup fourth round for the first time in 19 years. Torquay completed the double over champions Burton Albion in their final match. Tim Sills was leading marksman as Torquay qualified for the Conference National play-offs in fourth place. The Gulls beat Histon 2-1 on aggregate in the semi-finals, then defeated Cambridge United 2-0 in the Wembley final.

**The Gulls secured a narrow 1-0 win over Luke Garrard's side, ending a nine-match winless streak and to keep their National League survival hopes alive.**




Asa Hall's decisive goal came on 30 minutes, steering in a Kevin Dawson cross to steal all three points. Frank Nouble had the chance to extend the lead before half-time, Nathan Ashmore made a stunning save to keep the Wood in contention.

Luke Garrard's men, aiming to end their own three-game winless run, pushed hard for an equaliser with Dennon Lewis hitting the side-netting and Zak Brunt seeing an effort saved by Mark Halstead in between the Torquay sticks. Despite intense late pressure, including seven minutes of stoppage time, the visitors held firm to move within six points of safety, while the result dented the Wood's play-off ambitions.
