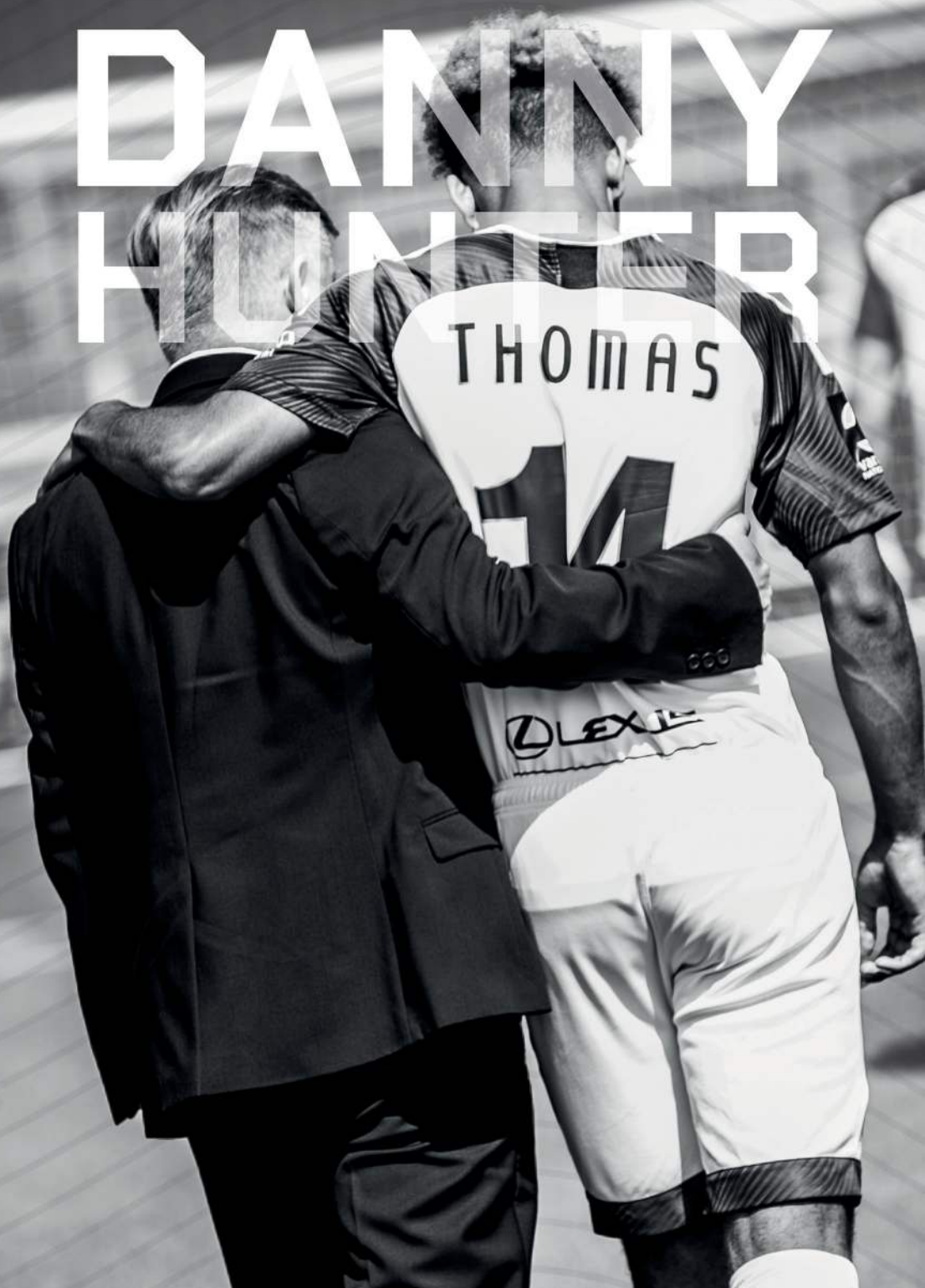

# DANNY HUNTER





***Tonight, we welcome Truro City to the Mangata Pay UK stadium. May I wish their Directors, Manager, players and supporters an enjoyable time with us and a safe journey home later.***

Well, it's been another frustrating 10 days for the club since we exited the FA Cup on penalties against Leyton Orient - that was after deservedly dragging ourselves back from 2 down to 2-2, then scoring a "goal" in injury time to win it, but having it chalked off for offside.

The dressing room response since that cup tie has again been very mixed with a win against Farnborough and then a disastrous loss away to Aveley, who sat bottom at the time we played them.

This evening will be another strong indicator regarding peoples' attitude, discipline, desire and character, as we entertain a very good Truro side in a game that will test our resolve.

As an aside, I explained in my last notes about my plans to build the South End of the ground over the next few years. I hope to achieve the near impossible and start and finish the first two phases of the away end of the stadium by August 2026.

These plans will involve intensive talks with my architect, contractors, Hertsmere Borough Council, residents and all stakeholders - if I'm correct it will be a three phased affair but in my opinion they will happen.

As such, I must now produce realistic plans with the detail incorporated and with everything fully costed. In truth I must also be financially sure in what I'm doing as it will take huge investment on my side to give our supporters a completed stadium and, as I said, this will need a three phased approach, with a full planning application completed sometime in the early spring of 2025.

Regarding my short-term plans on the football side, it was very simple, we needed promotion, promotion, promotion and everyone knew this. This squad in truth hasn't shown anywhere near the desire or consistency required to remotely achieve that.

As such, our crowd averages have plummeted and a return to part time football for this club gets ever closer. That would genuinely break my heart but nobody should be surprised by that statement, as we are at present a very average National South team, and our crowds have dropped off a cliff this season.

NO club owner should be expected to maintain a top budget to remain full time at this level, with a dressing room that seemingly lacks desire and commitment, and on crowd averages of less than 750, while losing hundreds of thousands of pounds.

I have shown the home average league attendances in these notes, and you can see that if league placings were based on average home attendances, we would at present be in a relegation place..... "so your honour I rest my case".

I've done my very best for the last two seasons to support this squad and I don't think anyone can question my loyalty to this dressing room.

I hope both players and staff alike read what I'm writing and understand exactly what I'm saying as it will not change, but it does affect everything in my life, including my own footballing ambition which still burns brightly.

I'm hoping my honesty and transparency in these recent programme notes provokes conversation and perhaps even gets a positive reaction from both staff and players, but until now the dressing room have shown me they are a win one, draw one, lose one group and that doesn't look like changing anytime soon.

I hope people think seriously about what they actually expect from me and our local football club going forward. I hope my notes really do concentrate peoples' minds and I'm hoping this very talented and expensively put together dressing room, and our loyal 'old school' supporters (who I adore), know it's now you not me, who hold the key to our clubs' full-time future - it's in your hands.

That statement does bring a time pressure on us all to succeed, but pressure must be embraced if we want success. Pressure must be enjoyed if we want league titles and a season is not just about magic moments in the cup.

If we really do want sustained success, then that has to be aligned with attitude, discipline, desire and good performances on the pitch. These are the only things that will improve attendances and at present we are nowhere near good enough or anywhere close to being successful.

Trust me, our club, staff and dressing room are well backed financially, it is also cared for and loved, but at present it's full of unfulfilled talent and some weak individuals.

The budget is a great budget for this division, our training facilities are top class, our infra-structures are built and our work force is in place.....there really are no more excuses that I can stomach, because for many years we have eaten, trained and travelled like all good professional football clubs should.

In all honesty we've had squads here that were nowhere near as talented as this dressing room - but they would overrun this lot, simply through their desire, their togetherness and their work rate alone.

In truth for the rest of this season, we're going to see if we have the focus, motivation, character, attitude, discipline and desire on top of our undoubted ability to even try and get back to the National League this season, because at present that looks a long way off.

Whoever you support, let's hope for an open, attacking game and may the best team win.

## Manager: John ASKEY

John Askey, born in Stoke-on-Trent, began his playing career at Port Vale before making over 500 appearances for Macclesfield Town, where he later managed, achieving promotion to the Football League despite financial challenges. After managerial stints at Shrewsbury, Port Vale, and York City, where he led the Minstermen to the National League, winning promotion from the National League North, Askey briefly managed Hartlepool United. In June 2024, he joined Truro City as manager, replacing Paul Wotton, who moved to Torquay United.

# ONES TO WATCH



## Connor RILEY-LOWE

**Born:** Paington - 10 January 1996

**Position:** Defender

Club captain, Connor Riley-Lowe began his career at Exeter City, signing professionally in 2014 and making 14 appearances, with standout loan spells at Truro City. Released in 2017, he joined Truro permanently, earning Player of the Year honours twice before moving to Bath City in 2019. Riley-Lowe returned to Truro in 2020, winning Player of the Year again in 2021-22 and 2022-23, and scoring the winning goal in a memorable play-off final against Bracknell Town.



## Dan LAVERCOMBE

**Born:** Torquay - 21 October 1996

**Position:** Goalkeeper

In June 2024, Lavercombe joined Truro City on a two-year deal after a season with Taunton Town, where he made 39 appearances and kept 12 clean sheets. He started his career at Torquay United, earning a move to Wigan Athletic in 2016 before loan returns to Torquay and Rhyl. After spells with AFC Fylde and FC United of Manchester, where he was Supporters' Player of the Year in 2022-23, he now anchors Truro's defence. and 2023/24 seasons.



## Tyler HARVEY

**Born:** Plymouth - 29 June 1995

**Position:** Striker

Tyler Harvey rose through Plymouth Argyle's ranks, making 50 appearances before moving to Wrexham. Joining Truro City in 2017, he quickly became prolific, scoring in the FA Cup first-round clash against Charlton Athletic. Harvey netted 25 goals in Truro's last Step Two season before a brief stint at Bath City in 2019-20, soon returning to Truro. The 29-year-old has since led the team's scoring charts, including the first goal at Truro's new stadium.

Football historian **LEIGH EDWARDS** selects ten post-war Truro City 'Classic Campaigns'

---

### 1992/93

Truro City won the South Western League and Cup 'double' for the only time in 1992/93. Under manager Steve Massey, the brother-in-law of Dragons' Den businesswoman Deborah Meaden, they won 23 of their 32 South Western League games and had the best defensive record. Truro stormed to 5-0 wins at home to both Appledore and Porthleven, also winning 6-0 at Wadebridge. Steve Wherry was leading marksman with 20 goals as they gained 49 points, finishing three ahead of runners-up Bodmin Town. It was Truro's first title triumph for 23 years. They also won the South Western League Cup for the third time, beating Falmouth Town 4-1 in the final.

### 2005/06

Truro City finished South Western League runners-up in 2005/06. Dave Leonard's side won 22 of their 34 games and had the best defensive record, conceding just 29 goals. Truro beat St Austell 6-0 and Goonhavern 5-0 at Treyew Road, also gaining 4-0 wins over Callington Town, Millbrook, Penryn Athletic and Porthleven. They finished runners-up to Bodmin Town with 73 points and were promoted to the Western League First Division. Truro had been founding members of the South Western League in 1951. They reached the FA Vase second round, beating Launceston 3-1, Torrington 4-0 and Witney United 3-1 before losing 3-2 at Christchurch.

### 2006/07

Truro City won the FA Vase in 2006/07. Dave Leonard's side beat Wadebridge Town 5-2, Bitton 2-1, St Blazey 3-2, Lymington Town 1-0, Newcastle BBP 3-1, Slimbridge 3-0, Whitehawk 1-0 and Curzon Ashton 3-2 in the FA Vase to

reach the final for the first time. Two goals by Kevin Wills plus another from Joe Broad gave them a 3-1 victory over AFC Totton in front of a record 27,754 crowd at the new Wembley Stadium, becoming the first Cornish football club to win a national trophy. Truro also won the Western League First Division title at the first attempt. They won 37 of their 42 games and lost just once, scoring an incredible 185 goals, gaining 115 points.

### 2007/08

Truro City won the Western League Premier Division title at the first attempt in 2007/08. Dave Leonard's side won 33 of their 40 games and were the highest scorers with 132 goals. They swept to 8-0 wins at home to Chard Town and Street, also trouncing Ilfracombe 7-1, Bristol Manor Farm 6-0, Radstock Town 6-0 and Calne Town 5-0 at Treyew Road. Truro triumphed 8-1 at Odd Down and gained a thrilling 8-5 win at Radstock. Gaining 103 points, they finished 17 ahead of runners-up Dawlish Town and became the first Cornish club to play in the Southern League. They lost their grip on the FA Vase, losing 3-0 at home to Whitley Bay in the fifth round.

### 2008/09

Truro City won the Southern League First Division South & West title in 2008/09. Dave Leonard had resigned as manager after securing promotion for the third consecutive season and was replaced by Sean McCarthy as Truro prepared for life in the Southern League. They won 29 of their 42 games and were the highest scorers with 120 goals. Truro stormed to a 9-1 win at Andover and gained a 7-1 victory at AFC Hayes. Winning 5-0 at home to Winchester City and 4-0 against Abingdon, Andover and



Bracknell, they gained 95 points, finishing ten ahead of runners-up Windsor & Eton, securing four-goal wins both home and away against their closest rivals.

#### 2010/11

Truro City won the Southern League Premier Division title in 2010/11. They began with a 3-0 defeat at home to Chesham United but lost just one of their next 21 games under new manager Lee Hodges, beating Halesowen Town 6-0 and Chippenham Town 5-0 at Treyew Road. Barry Hayles grabbed hat-tricks as Truro won 6-0 at Salisbury City and 7-2 at home to Swindon Supermarine during the closing weeks. They were the highest scorers and clinched the title with a 3-0 victory at Banbury United in their penultimate match. Gaining 87 points, they finished four ahead of runners-up Hednesford Town, winning promotion to the Conference South.

#### 2014/15

Truro City were promoted back to the Conference South in 2014/15. They started with a 3-0 defeat at home to Chesham United but steadily climbed the Southern League Premier Division table under player-manager Steve Tully. Truro trounced Histon 7-2 at Treyew Road, with Isaac Vassell grabbing a hat-trick, then beat Bideford 5-1 on Boxing Day. They won all except four of their final 17 games and qualified for the play-offs in third place with 86 points. Truro defeated Hungerford Town 1-0 with a late goal by Isaac Vassell in the semi-finals, then Shane White's second-half penalty clinched a 1-0 victory at home to St Neots Town 1-0 in the play-off final.

#### 2015/16

Truro City qualified for the Conference South play-offs in 2015/16. They began life back at that level with a 1-1 draw at Margate and drew 2-2 at eventual champions Sutton United but won just one of their opening eight games, crashing to a 6-0 defeat at home to Oxford City. Lee Hodges' side soared up the table with just one defeat in 22 matches, including 4-4 draws at home to Maidenhead United and Wealdstone early in the New Year. They won 17 of their 42 games and

qualified for the play-offs in fourth place but lost 3-0 on aggregate to Maidstone United in the semi-finals. Truro took Macclesfield Town to an FA Trophy second round replay.

#### 2017/18

Truro City reached the FA Cup first round proper for the first time in 2017/18. They beat AFC Portchester 2-0, AFC Sudbury 4-1 and Hampton & Richmond Borough 2-0 in the FA Cup before Tyler Harvey scored in their 3-1 defeat by past FA Cup winners Charlton Athletic in front of 4,494 at The Valley. Truro also qualified for the Conference South play-offs again. Noah Keats grabbed a hat-trick in their 7-2 victory at home to Whitehawk as they gained six straight wins in September. They won 20 of their 42 games and gained 69 points. Qualifying for the play-offs in seventh place, they lost 3-1 at Hampton & Richmond Borough in that season's fourth meeting.



#### 2022/23

Truro City regained Conference South status in 2022-23. Paul Wotton's side were early Southern League Premier Division South leaders, unbeaten in their opening 16 games. They gained nine straight wins including a 6-0 victory at home to North Leigh before losing 3-1 at Chesham United. Truro drew 3-3 at Plymouth Parkway on Boxing Day and won 27 of their 42 games to qualify for the play-offs in third place with 89 points. After beating Poole Town 4-1 on penalties after a 1-1 draw in the semi-finals, goals by Tyler Harvey, Rocky Neal and Connor Riley-Lowe's last-minute goal gave them a dramatic 3-2 victory at Bracknell Town in the play-off final.

**Ian Allison's team endured a nightmare in Cornwall, losing both their unbeaten record and their discipline in a chaotic match that ended with just eight Wood players on the field.**




The game started with promise as loan signing Mauro Vilhete, back from Barnet, showed his skill and created early chances. However, Wood's control slipped after a quick counterattack led to Truro's opening goal.

The turning point came just before halftime when a rash challenge by Ben Nunn led to a heated confrontation. ## COMMUNITY TRUST LAUNCH YOUTH GOALKEEPER TRAINING

**The Boreham Wood Community Trust is thrilled to announce the launch of weekly goalkeeping training following the upcoming October half term, beginning on Friday 8 November.**

These specialist sessions will be hosted by Boreham Wood FC's First Team Goalkeeping Coach Jordan Kelly, who is a UEFA B qualified goalkeeping coach. Jordan arrived at Boreham Wood in the summer from his native Guernsey where he worked across all ages from under 7's up to senior football, as well as working within the Guernsey national team set-up.

Just like our other weekly training sessions, these sessions will be structured to improve budding goalkeepers in all areas of the specialist position, such as handling, positioning, techniques, save types and distribution, to name just a few.

Session topics will include, but are not limited to basic handling, positioning, 1-on-1's, defending crosses, diving, in-possession distribution, save types, communication, decision making and match scenario practice.

Sessions will take place weekly during the school term, every Friday from 17:30 to 19:00 for 7–14 year-olds.

Each session will cost £10.00, with discounts available for half-termly block bookings. For the first half-term period, from Friday 8 November to Friday 20 December, there is a discounted block booking of £60.00.


