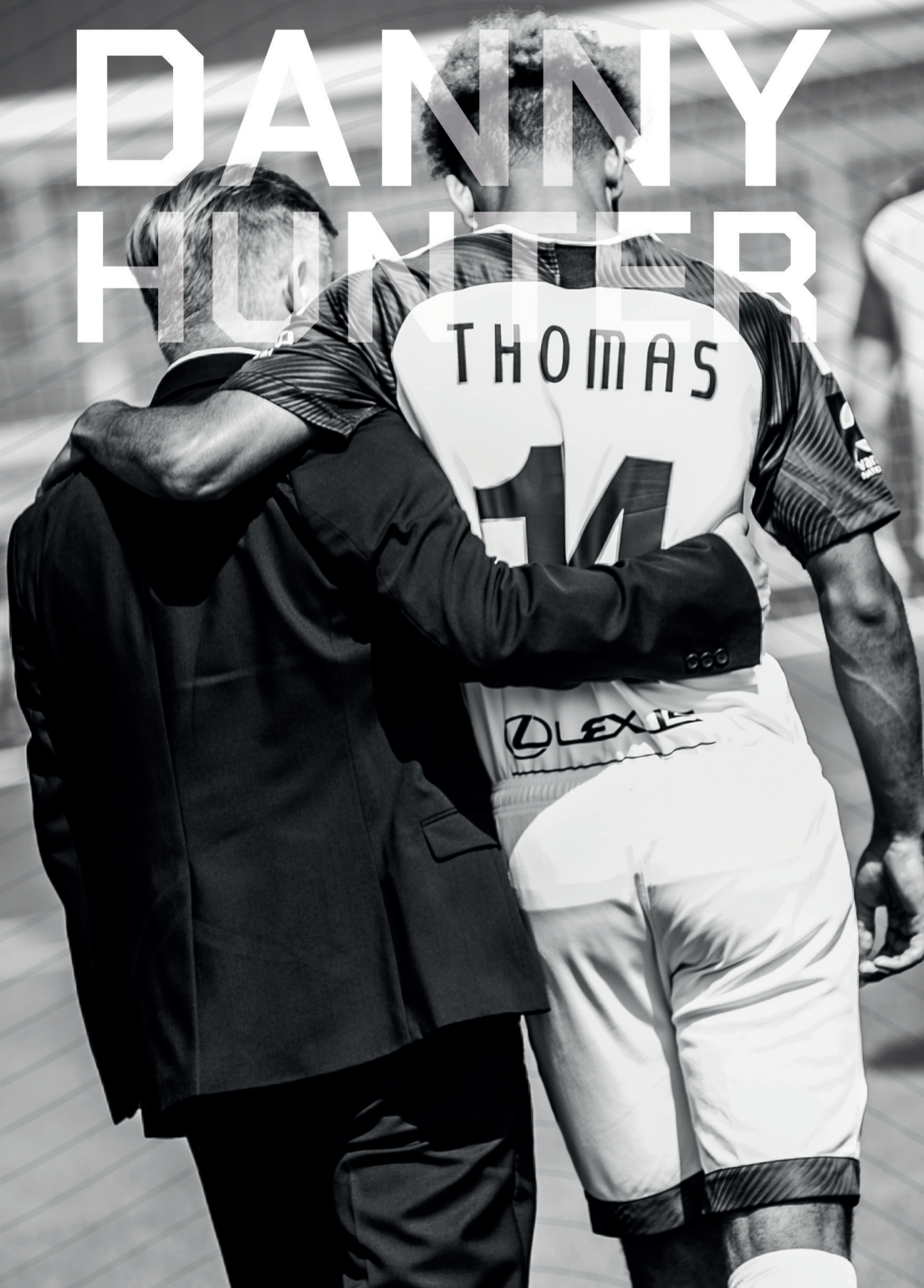

DANNY HUNTER



Today we welcome Felixstowe and Walton United to the Mangata Pay UK stadium. May I wish their Directors, players and supporters an enjoyable time with us and a safe journey home.

I believe this season is showing me that any success we might have is more about what we can produce consistently, rather than about the quality of the opposition we face each week in our league. It is the same in the cup and a home tie with Felixstowe and Walton United in the FA Trophy gives us a great chance to go further in the competition.

For our older supporters, you will no doubt remember back in 2005/06, when we were playing our football in the Southern League Eastern Division. Like now, we loved these types of cup days, and like now we were great underdogs and giant killers.

I well remember how we knocked out Crawley Town when they were a non-league club at their place in the FA Trophy. Our support that day was noisy, rowdy and different class. In truth we took our lead from our supporters that day, we played up, we triumphed against the odds and went all the way to the Trophy Semi Final.

So we know what Felixstowe will bring to the table today, we know they are dangerous and we will not underestimate them. We are also well aware of our opponent's league form and very aware that our opponents battered our old adversaries Bishop's Stortford in the last round 6-1.

Having said that, if we get beat this afternoon, we will not whinge or make excuses, we'll congratulate our opponents, wipe our mouths and we will be humble. We will accept we've been beaten by a better team from a lower division, then have our inquest and fully concentrate on our promotion ambitions, as that's all we would have left.

Experience tells me, there will be plenty of cup shocks today, but this game is more about us focusing on ourselves and working hard for a victory. That said, you often need a bit of luck in the cup, because on occasion things just don't work out for you, at times your players just don't turn up and when that happens, don't whine, don't whinge, wipe your mouth and deal with your performance and defeat.

Defeat doesn't always mean you are "defeated", as league programmes nowadays last 46 games, and everybody will get beaten or knocked down at times, as we were at Aveley last Saturday. It's more about getting back up and dealing with the setback, as we did against Truro on Tuesday, in reality it's dealing with setbacks that will ultimately define us. Losing and dealing with defeat is a big part of any football club's DNA and again that is proving to be the case for us this season.

Experience tells me that success in business or football is more about having the right people with the right characters and attitudes wrapped around you. We all need the right people to help us deal with our setbacks and our own failures at times. I like to work with people who understand that football in the main is simple, it's about playmakers, destroyers and finishers. It's obvious that you will get injuries and suspensions, you will at times make poor decisions and on occasions sign the wrong players, or even the right players who have wrong attitudes.

That's all part of the team-building process but you must stay focused and you must overcome, as you still need to win football matches. Setbacks and failure are a huge part of any team-building process if you want to create a successful season - but in football as in business, you must deal with setbacks if you want success to follow - in my experience, nothing worthwhile ever comes easy in this life.

I possibly get more disappointed when people choose to stay down when they're hardest hit and I get even more disappointed when they quit or wilt under pressure. Those are the actions of the weak, the actions of the entitled and it doesn't help me or them - these people must understand setbacks are unavoidable and if they throw in the towel every 5 minutes they will never achieve anything.

Setbacks have been a big part of my family, football and business life, but giving up when I'm most needed would for me be unforgivable. I don't believe you love or care for your family, staff, players, supporters, club, town or your community only when you're winning and things are going well. For me, you must love and care for them when things are tough, even more when things are difficult and even further more when things are desperate, and though we're not quite at the desperate stage, we are in a tough spot.

As we look to get ourselves a cup win today, it's important for me to possibly re-focus on what this season's realistic ambitions now are? Self-awareness, planning ahead and being pragmatic is an important part of a Chairman's life and in any rebuilding process you must be pragmatic. As such, I'm expecting evolution not revolution over the coming months and here are some easy-to-read stats, as our mini dressing room rebuild begins.

Our recent league results show me that if we continue our current form, though frustrating at times, it will improve our league position if mirrored until the end of the season. The data and numbers also show me that since Luke's return our points-per-game ratio is still consistently inconsistent, haha, but still ok. As such we can expect a slightly improved mid and second-half of the season points tally and here are my reasons for that statement;

Luke Garrard has now been back for 12 games.....8 in the league and 4 in the cup. Luke remained unbeaten through three rounds of the FA Cup only then losing out on penalties after drawing 2-2 against League One Leyton Orient in the FA Cup 1st Round Proper.

In the National League South, Luke is now eight games deep, he has a record of 4 wins, 2 draws and 2 defeats and that at present means we are slowly closing in on our play-off rivals. The dressing room has won 14 points from our last 8 league games, which gives us an average points return of 1.75 points per game.

It means if the dressing room can improve their performance and results just slightly, and improve on our recent 1.75 points per game ratio, it means we will comfortably finish in the top 7 and more likely 4th or 5th. However, if we can get our points per game ratio closer to, or above, 2 points per game, then we can still get ourselves into the top three, secure home advantage in the play-offs and even make a late challenge for the title.

At this stage of the season, our performances over the last week show me, we are nothing if not inconsistent. So unless we improve the squad, unless we improve the mindsets and unless we reverse our away form quickly, then I believe a 5th, 6th or 7th playoff position is perhaps the best we can hope for.

As such I believe a mini rebuild is now needed, as I still want the title and I still want to make my family, staff, dressing room, club, town and community proud - nothing's over until it's over.

Finally whoever you support, let's hope for an open, attacking game and may the best team win.

Good Afternoon, firstly I would like to welcome Stuart Boardley and his Staff and Players to the Mangata Pau UK Stadium for todays FA Trophy Second Round tie.

Felixstowe & Walton have had four fixtures in the competition prior to our game and have shown they have the quality to cause an upset, beating the likes of Bishop Stortford and Haringey Borough in the previous two rounds.

We will need to have the professional mindset we showed in the ties we faced in the early rounds of the FA Cup this Season and have the intensity and tempo to control a game of football.

Today is another opportunity for us to improve and continue our current form, it's important we get into a winning habit, it breeds confidence and a belief that is required to have a run which in turn allows for us to climb the table.

We will need to show a mentality in our play and have the work rate that warrants our progression in the Cup.

Let's get right behind the players and make this place a fortress it's starting to become.

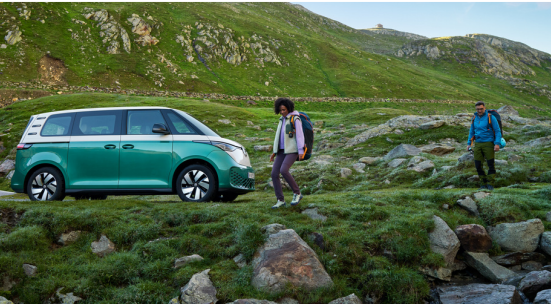

A reliable left-sided defender, Whight combines composure on the ball with a strong, accurate left foot. Known for his toughness and commitment, he brings defensive resilience and leadership to the back line, strengthening his team's defensive core.



Jack AINSLEY

Born: Ipswich - 17 September 1990

Position: Defender

Another player who began their career at Ipswich Town, Ainsley progressing through their academy to make four senior appearances under manager Roy Keane. Following his time with the Tractor Boys, he continued his career with Step three sides Lowestoft and Leiston, gaining valuable experience. Jack is highly regarded as a "Rolls Royce" player, a versatile and refined talent who can seamlessly adapt to any position, adding depth and quality across the team.



Samuel FORD

Born: Ipswich - 5 June 1998

Position: Striker

Samuel Ford, a talented forward, developed his skills in the academies of Ipswich Town and West Ham before embarking on a successful stint with Arbroath, where he helped the team come close to Scottish Premiership promotion. Notably, Ford gained experience abroad with Hume City FC in Australia. Now back at Felixstowe, Sam brings local roots and a sharp goal-scoring ability, adding significant firepower to the team's attack.

CLUB HISTORY

FELIXSTOWE & WALTON UTD



Felixstowe & Walton United Football Club aka 'The Seasideers' were formed in 2000 from two football clubs who were independent in their own right although they had merged briefly just prior to the Second World War to be called Felixstowe United (not to be confused with the Felixstowe United who played in The Suffolk & Ipswich League) The joining lasted until 1952 when the clubs went their separate ways.

Formed in 1895, Walton United played at The Recreation ground in Recreation Lane, Walton while Felixstowe Town, formed five years earlier played at The Town Ground, Dellwood Avenue. The second amalgamation in 2000 looked a good marriage for the right reasons. Walton United had just won the Suffolk

Senior Cup and were on the up but with nowhere to go as the Recreation ground at Walton could not accommodate Eastern Counties League standard facilities. Felixstowe Town had been renamed Felixstowe Port & Town due to their sponsorship by the Port, but when that was withdrawn in 1999/2000 it left the Town club struggling to recover and maintain Eastern Counties League football. It looked and proved to be a good decision by both clubs that they therefore merged with Dellwood Avenue becoming their home Venue.

It was a struggle in the early years after the merger with relegation coming in 2002, but it offered the chance for the club to regroup and focus on the future with a growing youth set up and getting the basics right off the pitch and the

club regained Premier Division status in 2006 when they finished runners up in Division One.

Tied by what could be done at their present home the club always found it difficult to compete with the top sides in the Premier Division with what was the unique task of raising and lowering of the floodlights before and after games and the restrictions placed on the club by the local authorities.

The Seasiders remained positive throughout and now have the lights permanently erected during the football season which was the catalyst to develop the rest of the ground and have an excellent youth set up comprising over 20 boys & girls teams from Age 6 upwards.

In July 2017 a new pitchside clubhouse complex opened to replace the old one which has transformed the club and by the end of the 2017/18 season, the Seasiders gained promotion to the Isthmian North Division at Step 4 for the first time in the clubs history. The Reserves were also promoted to the Step 6 Thurlow Nunn First Division.

The clubs first season at Step 4 saw a mid-table finish achieved, with an average attendance of 400 the highest in the Isthmian North, and second highest in Suffolk behind Ipswich Town. A number of additional ground improvements were completed and the season ended with a trip to Portman Road in the Suffolk FA Premier Cup with over 1,000 Seasiders supporters seeing us finish runners up to Step 3 Leiston after a 3-2 defeat.

The 2019/20 season proved to be a difficult one on and off the pitch with the resultant decision to null & void the campaign due to Covid-19, whereas the

Reserves took voluntary demotion to Step 7 and will compete in the Essex & Suffolk Border League.

2020/21 got off to a promising start in the league and a run to the 2nd Round proper of the FA Trophy before the campaign was again ended due to the pandemic.

Summer 2021 saw the Reserves re-branded as Under 23s, part of the clubs strategy to improve the development pathways within the club, alongside the Academy.

The Seasiders enjoyed one of their most successful seasons in their history in 2021/2022, again having a fantastic run in the FA Trophy that saw victories against higher league opposition before exiting in the 2nd round proper. In the Isthmian North league, an incredible run of form from the end of November onwards saw Felixstowe storm into the playoffs with a fifth place finish. Only a heartbreaking late defeat at Canvey Island denied a promotion playoff final appearance.

2022/2023 saw further improvements to the newly renamed AGL Arena, with two new stands opening, a new digital scoreboard and new fencing at each end. On the pitch, another exciting season developed as the Seasiders remained in the thick of the promotion race for the entire season, only missing out on another playoff place on the final day of the season.

2023/2024 The Seasiders narrowly missed out on promotion, losing in the playoff semifinal after a titanic season-long fight for the top spot with Lowestoft Town.

COMMUNITY TRUST LAUNCH YOUTH GOALKEEPER TRAINING

The Boreham Wood Community Trust is thrilled to announce the launch of weekly goalkeeping training following the upcoming October half term, beginning on Friday 8 November.

These specialist sessions will be hosted by Boreham Wood FC's First Team Goalkeeping Coach Jordan Kelly, who is a UEFA B qualified goalkeeping coach.
