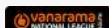

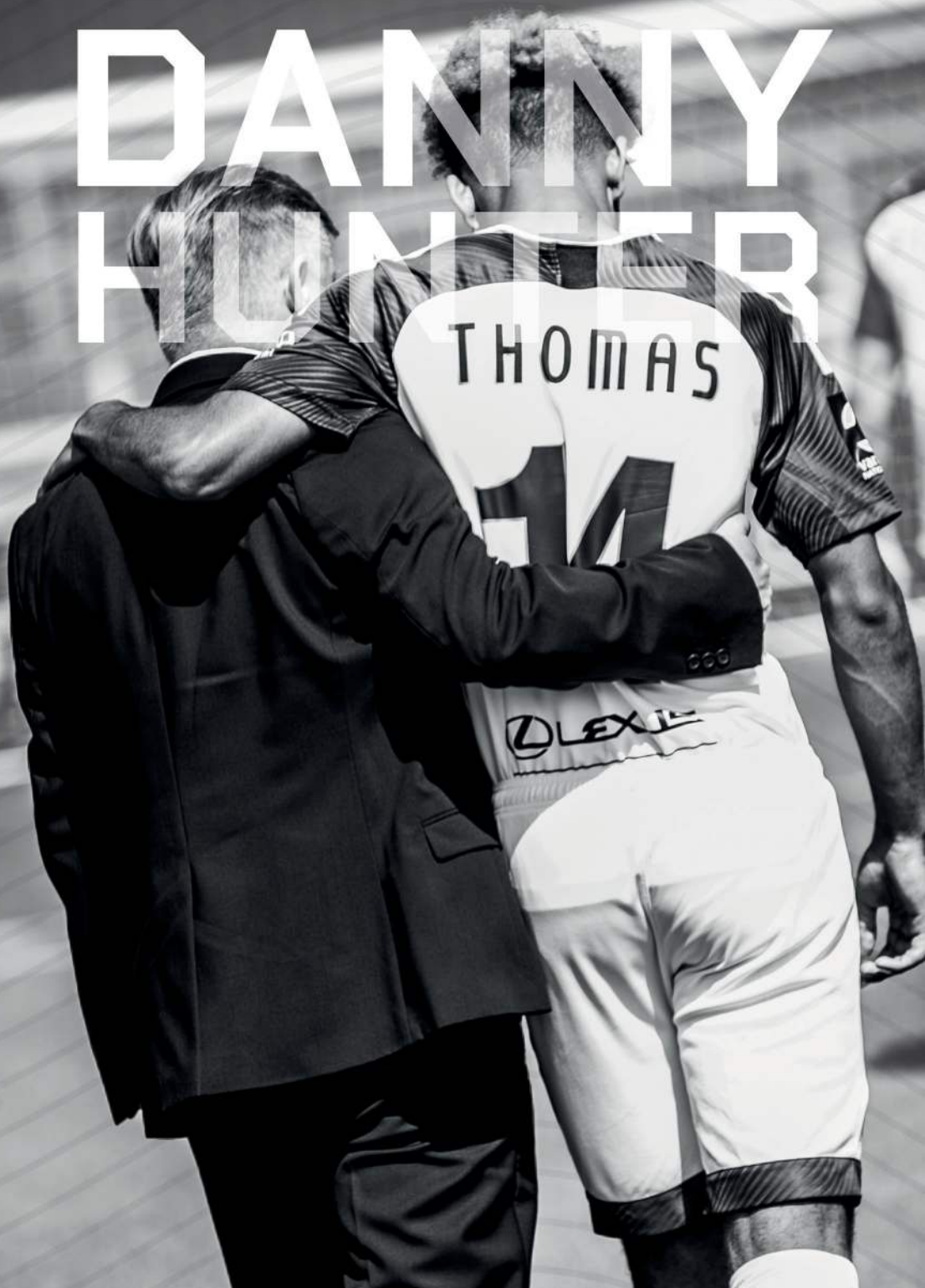

DANNY HUNTER



***Tonight we welcome St Albans City FC to the Mangata Pay UK stadium.
May I wish their Directors, Manager, players and supporters an
enjoyable stay with us and a safe short journey home.***

Well, November was a month of resets, reality checks, and an overall acceptance of where we presently sit within the league and what we need and must do to achieve our ambitions for this season.

Football aside, it has been a very good month for progressing my long-standing vision regarding our future and our stadium plans. As such, I can report to you without going into too much detail, that the planning, the consultation and the solution finding regarding the Brook Road Car Park, Meadow Park and our Stadium build at the South end of the ground, is now in full swing and well underway. With a fair wind, we hope to have a new full planning application in with HBC by April/May 2025, and approved by the summer of 2025, as I've had a pre-application at the South end of the ground with HBC for the last 18 months.

That pre-app was very helpful and after written feedback from the planning department and many face-to-face meetings, we are all now very hopeful that we are on the same page. All of that means that HBC Officers, Councillors, Executives, our residents, park users and the club can only benefit from a true collaboration and union.

In truth, the good news this pre-

Christmas has just kept on coming, because as of this morning [Tuesday, 10th December], after a long and thoughtful negotiation with myself, Charlie Hunter and the AFC and AWFC hierarchy, we have signed off on two improved, more rounded and mutually beneficial Arsenal and Arsenal Women 10-year contracts.

These long-term relationships and collaborations between BWFC, AFC and AWFC not only underpin long-standing friendships, but cement a long-standing partnership with my friends at Arsenal and it's these thoughtful agreements that enable us to go from strength to strength.

This is now my 26th season here in the Chair and in that time we have rebuilt the stadium, rebuilt the facility, we've had four promotions, five or six play-off seasons, we've even been to Wembley in a play-off final. We have also had numerous runs to the 1st and 2nd Round Proper of the FA Cup, whilst on three occasions had FA Cup runs to the 3rd, 4th and 5th rounds.

In fact the last time we met tonight's opponents was in the FA Cup after we had already beaten Barnet and Eastleigh. After beating St Albans City here, we went on to beat AFC Wimbledon and then AFC Bournemouth, before playing at Goodison Park and we were even in

the hat for the FA Cup quarter-finals that year.

Many non-league clubs will never experience that type of high..... that said, after a decade or more of many highs, a few lows and sustained success, we are now experiencing a comparative low and so we must stick together, stay resolute and find the right path to come back from our present setbacks, as I feel a new era of success is not that far away.

Our success on the pitch has helped me though with our stadium and facility improvements during that time. When aligned to great staff, thousands of man-hours put in and millions of pounds of investment, our facility builds and upgrades are now underpinning many of those other achievements and it's our foresight in facility investment which will I hope give us the platform to keep looking forward in the months and years ahead.

It's why I believe regardless of what is achieved on the pitch this season, and trust me I will support Luke and Charlie in every way possible with the budget, that we must re-focus as a club, still move it forward and complete the whole stadium, which could perhaps end up being my biggest achievement here.

With one eye on the future and another eye on my age - a completed four sided Stadium would be a personal milestone for years and years of working toward a bigger

vision and a plan but also reward for working with so many great people, as the investment in our staff and facility has led to real growth.

To be clear, the new build at the south end of the ground will cost millions - but would allow us to create an away fans zone and community area, allow us to put in extra toilets, digital turnstiles, and a new covered South Stand similar to the North Bank. It will create great lighting and signage, enhance the Park and improve car parking and will also allow us to put in a fans bar and food outlets at the away end, and even create a new access road off Brook Road Car Park directly into the ground.

All of this means I could complete the project in three stages and the aim is to have the first phase completed by Christmas 2025 and the Second phase by late summer 2026. The third phase which includes taking our overall seating capacity up to 2,000 is yet to be scheduled, but you can rest assured that I will make sure we are EFL compliant.

What does EFL compliant mean? Firstly it means having a Stadium that can hold upwards of 5,000 supporters, whilst having a 2,000 seating capacity within that total. Of course, it means the exits, entrances, sight lines, turnstiles, floodlights and all things in between can deal with the overall capacity and be compliant with all EFL rules.

Our new designs will show a fantastic new covered South Stand similar to the North Bank, how we can achieve 2,000 seats and the away end visuals will encompass new toilets, a new away bar/hospitality area, food outlets, digital turnstiles, lighting, signage, community areas, a new access road and even a new ground teams office area. The latter will also house a new irrigation tank, a new maintenance building for the mowers, machinery etc and storage compound.

I've worked hand in glove with HBC officers and Councillors for more than 25 years and we've completed many projects together - but I've never seen them more enthused, energised, forward-thinking and collaborative in all my time here. In truth this park, car park and stadium project and the collaboration with HBC are exciting and I feel their enthusiasm is down to years and years of honest and robust conversation between us all, which has perhaps led to complete trust in each other and what our roles are within our community.

As such, by the end of January, I hope to be in a position to unveil to you all some truly stunning visuals, but until then the Park, Car Park and Stadium updates are over, and I'll get on with the behind-closed-door meetings and the matters in hand to keep things on track and moving forward.

Back to tonight and, of course, our friends from St Albans City are the visitors and stand in the way of us

entering one of the play-off positions. They have recently appointed Ian Culverhouse as their new gaffer and he is someone I've long admired and respected from afar. His and Paul Bastock's appointment makes tonight's assignment that much harder - but these are the nights that you have to deal with and local derbies are obstacles you must overcome if you genuinely want to maintain your promotion ambitions.

No doubt the atmosphere this evening, as in any local derby, will be noisy and partisan from both sets of supporters so let's enjoy this sporting rivalry as it's been a while, but let's also remember to maintain the long-standing friendships built among so many people from our Town and their City. Being partisan is what makes sporting rivalry the best but let's remember it's still a game and when the game is over, our friendships and respect remain and they do matter.

Lastly, whoever you support let's hope for an open, attacking game and may the best team win.

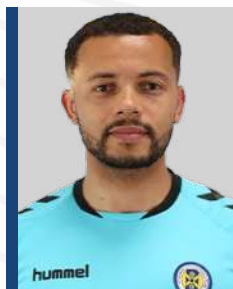
IN THE DUGOUT

Ian Culverhouse began coaching at Brighton before holding roles at Barnet, Leyton Orient, and Wycombe. He worked alongside Paul Lambert at Colchester, Norwich, and Aston Villa before managerial stints at King's Lynn Town, Grantham, Kettering, and Boston United. Culverhouse led King's Lynn to successive promotions, including a National League North title via points-per-game in 2020. He also secured promotion with Boston in 2024. On the 28th of November, Culverhouse was appointed manager of the Saints.

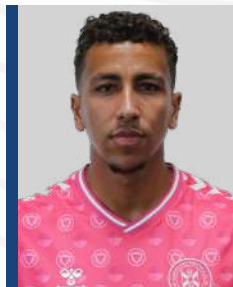


Michael JOHNSON

Born: 28 October 1993

Position: Goalkeeper

Michael Johnson joined St Albans City ahead of the 2020/21 season, quickly becoming a key player, making 120 appearances for the Saints since. The shot stopper gained recognition at Hitchin Town, where he made 184 appearances and became a fan favourite. After a standout spell at Braintree Town in 2019, he briefly joined Dagenham & Redbridge before the 2019/20 season was cut short. At Clarence Park, Johnson has solidified his reputation as a reliable and influential goalkeeper.

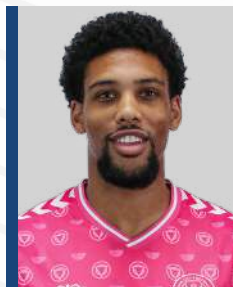


Zane BANTON

Born: Stevenage - 6 June 1996

Position: Striker

Banton originally joined St Albans City on loan in March 2017, scoring twice in six games before being recalled by Luton Town. Released by Luton that summer, he signed permanently with the Saints in the June of 2017, later extending his contract for the 2018/19 campaign. The forward notably scored a memorable goal in their Emirates FA Cup First Round Proper victory over Forest Green Rovers, solidifying his impact at Clarence Park.



Shaun JEFFERS

Born: Bedford - 14 April 1992

Position: Striker

Former Wood man Shaun Jeffers began his career at Coventry City, making his debut in 2009. After loan spells at Cheltenham, Cambridge United, and Tamworth, he played for Peterborough United, Newport County, and Yeovil Town. Moving into non-league football, Jeffers excelled at Chelmsford City, the Wood, and Brackley Town. Jeffers joined the Saints in 2020 and became the Vanarama National League South's record scorer with 129 goals in April of this year.

CLASSIC CAMPAIGNS

ST ALBANS CITY

Football historian **LEIGH EDWARDS** selects ten post-war St Albans City 'Classic Campaigns'

1968/69

St Albans City reached the FA Cup second round proper for the first time in 1968/69. They beat Wycombe Wanderers 1-0, after a 0-0 draw, Erith & Belvedere 3-2, Hitchin Town 2-0 and Corby Town 1-0 to reach the FA Cup first round proper for the first time in 42 years. Bobby Childs' penalty gave them a 1-1 draw at Wealdstone and Dave Neville scored to clinch a 1-0 victory in the replay watched by a 5,108 crowd at Clarence Park. Bill Ratty's goal secured a 1-1 draw at home to Walsall in front of a 4,867 crowd in the second round before Saints lost 3-1 in the replay watched by a 10,626 crowd at Fellows Park. They finished seventh in the Isthmian League.

1969/70

St Albans City reached the Amateur Cup semi-finals in 1969/70. They beat Wembley 2-1 at the third attempt, after a 0-0 draw and 1-1 draw, Harwich & Parkeston 3-1, Tow Law Town 4-0 and Wycombe Wanderers 2-0 to reach the Amateur Cup semi-finals for the first time in 44 years. John Butterfield scored to give Saints a 1-1 draw with Dagenham at The Den but they lost 1-0 in the semi-final replay at Kenilworth Road. They finished sixth in the Isthmian League, winning 21 of their 38 games and gaining 50 points. St Albans defeated Hitchin Town 2-1 in the Herts Charity Cup final but lost 4-2 to the same opponents in the London Senior Cup final.

1980/81

St Albans City reached the FA Cup second round proper for the second time in 1980/81. They beat Chesham United 1-0, Harrow Borough 4-3, Dulwich Hamlet 2-1 and Harwich & Parkeston 3-0, after a 2-2 draw,

to reach the FA Cup first round proper. Two penalties by Ian Whitehead secured a 2-1 win at Gravesend & Northfleet. Paul Mayles scored to give St Albans a 1-1 draw at home to Torquay United in the second round before they lost 4-1 in the replay. They finished fifth in the Isthmian League First Division, winning 24 of their 42 games and gaining 77 points. Top scorer Jon Sille and ever-present Ian Whitehead netted 34 goals between them.

1983/84

St Albans City were promoted straight back to the Isthmian League First Division in 1983/84. Laurie Ryan scored five times in their 10-0 FA Cup preliminary round win at home to Banstead Athletic. They lost two of their opening four Isthmian League games but just two more of their next 38 matches, trouncing Horsham 5-0, Barton Rovers 6-2 and Eastbourne United 6-1. Paul Mayles scored four goals in their 5-1 victory at home to Ware. They won 29 of their 42 Isthmian League First Division games and finished runners-up with 96 points. Paul Mayles was leading marksman with 33 goals, while goalkeeper Mark Pearson was the only ever-present.

1985/86

St Albans City won the Isthmian League First Division title in 1985/86. John Mitchell's side won 23 of their 42 games and were the highest scorers with 92 goals. They hammered Leatherhead 6-2, also slamming four goals past Hornchurch and Leytonstone/Ilford at Clarence Park. A thrilling title race went to the final day of the season and Saints gained 80 points, pipping Bromley to the championship on goal difference after winning 7-1 at Lewes. Leading marksman Steve Perrin, 'Player of

the Year' Gary Keen and ever-present captain John Watt scored 51 goals between them. Goalkeeper Mark Pearson was ever-present for the third consecutive season.

1996/97

St Albans City reached the FA Cup second round proper for the third time in 1996/97. They beat London Colney 4-1, after a 0-0 draw, Yeading 1-0, after a 1-1 draw, Stansted 5-1 and Witney Town 4-0 to reach the FA Cup first round proper. Two goals by Greg Howell gave them a 2-1 victory at Wisbech Town. Steve Clark and Jon Daly scored as they crashed to a 9-2 defeat against Bristol City watched by a 7,136 crowd at Ashton Gate in the second round. Jimmy Neighbour's side finished sixth in the Isthmian League Premier Division after losing only two of their final 15 games. Steve Clark was leading marksman, while Jon Daly was 'Player of the Year'.

1998/99

St Albans City FA Trophy semi-finalists in 1998/99. Garry Hill's side beat Leyton Pennant 3-0, Hastings Town 3-0, Ashton United 2-1, after a 2-2 draw, Dagenham & Redbridge 2-1 and Boston United 2-1 to reach the FA Trophy semi-finals for the first time. Peter Risley's goal gave them a 1-1 draw at home to Forest Green Rovers in the first-leg but they lost 3-2 in the second-leg. Steve Clark was leading marksman with 28 goals as they finished sixth in the Isthmian League Premier Division, losing just eight of their 42 games. Steve Clark scored twice as they triumphed 5-1 at home to Bishop's Stortford on Boxing Day during a 15 match unbeaten run.

2005/06

St Albans City won promotion to the Conference National for the first time in 2005/06. Colin Lippiatt's side began with two defeats but dropped just two points in their next seven Conference South games, with Matthew Hann grabbing a hat-trick in their 5-0 win at home to Eastbourne Borough. Tom Davis was another hat-trick hero in their 5-2 win at home to Yeading in November. Saints went top with five straight wins after Christmas. They won 27 of their 42 games

and were the highest scorers, finishing runners-up to Weymouth with 86 points. Goals by Lee Clarke and Paul Hakim secured a 2-0 win over Histon in the Conference South play-off final.

2013/14

St Albans City won promotion back to the Conference South in 2013/14. They lost four of their opening nine Southern League Premier Division games but John Frendo scored four goals in their 5-2 win at AFC Totton. Saints triumphed 7-3 at Truro City and reached the FA Cup first round proper for the first time in 12 years, losing 8-1 at home to Mansfield Town watched by a 3,251 crowd. They lost 2-1 at home to eventual winners Cambridge United in the FA Trophy second round. St Albans qualified for the Southern League Premier Division play-offs in fourth place, beating Cambridge City 4-2, then Chesham United 3-1 in the play-off final.



2021/22

St Albans City defeated Football League opposition in the FA Cup for the first time in 97 years in 2021/22. Ian Allinson's side beat Concord Rangers 2-0, after a 0-0 draw, Metropolitan Police 3-1, after a 0-0 draw and Corinthian Casuals 4-2 on penalties, after two 1-1 draws, to reach the FA Cup first round proper. Goals by Mitchell Weiss, Zane Benton and Shaun Jeffers gave Saints, unbeaten in their previous 14 games, a stunning 3-2 victory at home to League Two leaders Forest Green Rovers screened live on BBC Two. They lost 4-0 at Hertfordshire rivals Boreham Wood in the second round. St Albans finished ninth in the Conference South.

Boreham Wood triumphed 4-0 over St Albans City in a Hertfordshire derby watched by a record 4,101 fans.




The hosts started strongly, with early chances for Scott Boden and Tyrone Marsh, but they struggled to convert. St Albans nearly capitalised, with Joy Mukena and Callum Adebisi threatening from set-pieces. However, Josh Rees gave Wood the lead with a half-volley after a defensive scramble.

Rees doubled his tally shortly after halftime, heading in a Kane Smith cross. Despite brief resistance, St Albans failed to maintain possession or create significant chances, with Kyran Wiltshire deflected shot their best effort. Wood's dominance was sealed by Gus Mafuta's header and Adrian Clifton's calm finish, the latter scoring moments after coming on. Luke Garrard's side controlled the game throughout, securing a comfortable win and progressing in the competition.


